#### Registration:

Registration forms will be available starting **April 27, 2015**. Obtain Registration Form and signature of approval from your 2014-2015 school counselor. **YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED** for registration without both sides of the form completed and signed. Present the completed form at the Trinity High School registration of classes according to the registration schedule.

**Registration and tuition fees are to be paid IN FULL at this time. NO EXCEPTIONS!** (Visa, MasterCard and Discover credit cards accepted)



### HEB ISD Regular Summer School

#### Credit Recovery and Credit Acceleration

The 2015 summer school program has been designed to better serve the needs of district students. The summer school program includes a nine-day trimester schedule for students who are repeating a course for credit (Credit Recovery) and a thirteen-day semester schedule for students who are taking a course for the first time to earn credit (Credit Acceleration).

Students electing to take a nine-day trimester course will be provided an intensive review of the major course concepts and must successfully complete an end-of-course exam to receive credit in the course. Trimester courses are scheduled from 7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Because of the intensive nature of the trimester course, students will only be allowed to take one course per trimester.

Students electing to take the thirteen-day semester course will be provided an intensive and fast paced curriculum covering the major course concepts. Because students have not had prior instruction in course content, outside assignments should be expected. Credit will be awarded for the semester course based upon successful completion of in-class and out-of-class assignments. Semester courses are scheduled from 7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Because the semester course is also an intensive course of study, students will only be allowed to take one course per semester.

*Students should consult with their counselors for registration information and course approval.*

#### Credits:

Students taking courses in which they have had prior instruction may earn a maximum of 1.5 credits in the summer school program. However, students taking courses in which they have had no prior instruction may only earn a maximum of 1 credit.

#### Refunds:

There will be **NO REFUND** of the registration fee. Any tuition refund will be mailed directly to parents on the basis of the following: **50% tuition refund the first two days, with NO REFUND thereafter.**

#### Student Eligibility:

The summer school program is open to Hurst-Euless-Bedford ISD students and students from outside the district in grades 7-12. If an adequate number of certified teachers are not available, out-of district students will not be allowed to attend.

Basic classes are available to HEB ISD eligible Special Education students needing credit in a 7-12 English or Math classes.

\*Students must clear all fees and fines and return all books to their home campus to be eligible for registration. Students on fine lists **will not** be allowed to register.

**All classes will be held Monday - Thursday.  
7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.**

Breakfast and lunch will be served at Trinity HS - 7:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. Monday – Thursday. Summer School students will have an opportunity to eat lunch from 1:00 – 1:30 p.m. This is a free service of HEB ISD and is available to children one to 18 years of age, with no registration or proof of income, age, or residency.

This is an information sheet only! When you know positively the classes you will be taking, see your present counselor for a registration form and course approval. Registration forms will be available starting April 27, 2015.

**YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED** for registration without both sides of the form completed and signed.

HEB ISD reserves the right to cancel any course if there is insufficient enrollment to "make" the course or if certified staff is not available to teach the course.

### General Rules & Regulations

- The standards of dress and grooming will be the same as required under policy during the regular school term.
- Students must provide their own transportation.
- More than one (1) absence in a trimester or semester class for any reason will result in the student being dropped from said class without grade or credit. Three (3) tardies in any one class will be counted as one (1) absence. Tardy is defined as reporting to any given class within the first 20 minutes after the bell rings. Being late more than 20 minutes is considered an absence.
- No food or drink will be permitted in the classrooms or in the hallways.
- Students who violate tobacco, alcohol, drug, and weapon policies as described in the Student Code of Conduct will be dropped from summer school, and may receive additional consequences under school board policy.
- All other policies, rules, and regulations that apply during the regular term will be followed.
- REFUNDS:
  - \*If a class doesn't "make," a full refund, including registration fee, will be given.
  - \*If a student is dropped for discipline reasons or lack of attendance, **NO** refund will be given.
  - \*If a class is dropped at student's or parent's request on or before the second day of class, there will be no refund of the registration fee. There will be a 50% refund on tuition. After the second day, there will be no refund.
  - \*If a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Trimester class or a 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester class is dropped before the first day of class, there will be no refund of the registration fee. There will be a full refund of tuition.

**Any refund will be mailed directly to parents at their home address. Please allow 30 days for refunds to be processed.**
